Conference Theme – Titus 2:3–5

- “Older women... teach what is good. Then they can urge the younger women...”
- Emphasis on mentoring, generational discipleship, and lasting impact.

Conference Objectives



- **Awareness:** Help older women recognize their biblical mandate and the urgent need to disciple, while helping younger women understand their value and place in God's design.
- **Calling:** Guide both older and younger women in discovering their unique calling—whether as mentors or as young leaders growing in Christ.
- **Example:** Encourage all women to model holiness, reverence, and self-control, becoming examples and encouragers to one another.
- **Connection:** Foster meaningful intergenerational relationships and celebrate the beauty and strength of mutual learning and growth.
- **Urgency:** Address the challenges faced by younger women today
- **Growth:** Emphasize the need for continual learning and transformation to remain relevant and impactful.
- **Availability:** Affirm that God uses willing hearts at every stage of life—whether beginning the journey or guiding others along the path.

Perspectives



Strong Intergenerational Potential

The Titus 2:3–5 theme resonated well, showing that older and younger women both desire mentoring and discipleship relationships. This creates a foundation for ongoing intergenerational discipleship initiatives.

Momentum and Engagement

With 66 participants from 8 regions and over 30 women committing to continue, there is clear momentum to build on. The financial contributions (2.1M raised in just 3 months) also show strong ownership of the ministry.

Spiritual and Relational Impact

Testimonies reflect transformation: restored relationships, new networks, and a deeper sense of calling. This highlights that the conference went beyond inspiration—it sparked action and commitment.

Opportunities for Wider Reach

The conference succeeded in empowering and inspiring women, but the expressed need for implementation support indicates that more structured follow-up could multiply long-term impact.



Next Steps



Follow-up Discipleship Framework

Develop a mentorship roadmap pairing older and younger women regionally or across regions

Regional Clusters & Check-ins

Schedule quarterly virtual or in-person check-ins to track growth, share testimonies, and provide encouragement.

Implementation Support for Commitments

Identify the 30+ women who expressed desire to act and provide coaching, accountability groups, or leadership training.

Documentation & Storytelling

More testimonies to highlight ongoing transformation. Use them for encouragement, fundraising, & future events.

Sustain Financial Engagement

Establish a sustainable giving program (Women Empowerment Program, LTFP of the Ministry, etc.)

Plan Next Gathering

Annual national conference or rotating regional conferences leading up to another national one?
Build in structured learning and practical workshops that focus on real-life discipleship application.
