How does God reveal himself to us in the text? <u>Prayer:</u> That God's word fully transforms us in our character and mind, for a better ministry, couple and family life.	How does God reveal himself to us in the text? <u>Prayer:</u> -That we no longer live according to the flesh ;; -That the Holy Spirit of God dwells in us - That God restores life to our mortal bodies ; so that upon leaving this conference, women may always be guided by the Spirit, and everything that was dead receives new life (ministry, project, body cells, etc.)	How does God reveal himself to us in the text? <u>Prayer:</u> - That God grants us a persevering spirit. -That we learn to be rooted in His promises. - That our faith be firm and rooted in God's promises. - That we no longer neglect prayer and the word of God.	How does God reveal himself to us in the text? <u>Prayer:</u> - That God helps us know our own worth and that of our neighbour. - That the Lord helps us understand that we have value in His eyes - That we will leave this conference with greater self-confidence, knowing the value and dignity of every person we will preach the gospel to.	How does God reveal himself to us in the text? <u>Prayer:</u> -That God helps us show love to one another (being patient, kind, not envying, not boasting, not being proud, not being dishonest, not getting angry, not suspecting evil; always seeking the other's interest) - That henceforth we know how to communicate love to our neighbour when we preach the Gospel.
